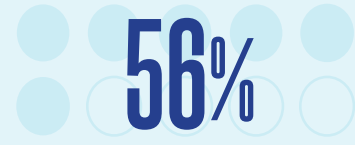

Bullock County's First Class Pre-K Classrooms are located in:

To reach 70 percent of all four-year-olds, Bullock County would need approximately:

1 additional First Class Pre-K Classroom

\$120,000 in additional funding*

\$25,000 in one time start-up costs
