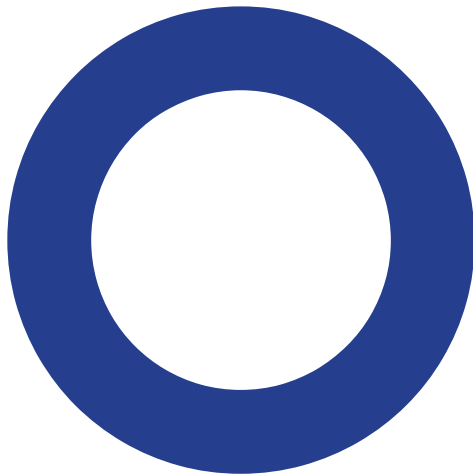
7 First Class Pre-K Classrooms

### Chambers County's First Class Pre-K Classrooms are located in:

- Community Organization Operated
- Child Care
- Faith Based
- Head Start
- Private School
- 7 Public School
- University Operated

To reach 70 percent of all four-year-olds, Chambers County would need approximately:

8 additional First Class Pre-K Classrooms

\$960,000 in additional funding\*

\$200,000 in one time start-up costs
