
In the 2020-2021 School Year:

Clay County's First Class Pre-K Classrooms are located in:

- O Community Organization Operated
- O Child Care
- Faith Based
- 2 Head Start
- O Private School
- O Public School
- University Operated

To reach 70 percent of all four-year-olds, Clay County would need approximately:

4 additional First Class Pre-K Classrooms

\$480,000 in additional funding*

\$100,000 in one time start-up costs

*The additional funding can come from a combination of local, state, federal, or other sources.
