
# In the 2020-2021 School Year:

# Coffee County's First Class Pre-K Classrooms are located in:

- O Community Organization Operated
- O Child Care
- Faith Based
- 2 Head Start
- O Private School
- 12 Public School
- University Operated

To reach 70 percent of all four-year-olds, Coffee County would need approximately:

additional First Class Pre-K Classrooms \$1,320,000 in additional funding\*

\$275,000 in one time start-up costs

\*The additional funding can come from a combination of local, state, federal, or other sources.
