## **Crenshaw County's First Class Pre-K Classrooms are located in:**

## To reach 70 percent of all four-year-olds, Crenshaw County would need approximately:

2 additional First Class Pre-K Classrooms \$240,000 in additional funding\*

\$50,000 in one time start-up costs

\*The additional funding can come from a combination of local, state, federal, or other sources.
