
## In the 2020-2021 School Year:

## Greene County's First Class Pre-K Classrooms are located in:

## To reach 70 percent of all four-year-olds, Greene County would need approximately:

additional First Class Pre-K Classroom \$120,000 in additional funding\*

\$25,000 in one time start-up costs
