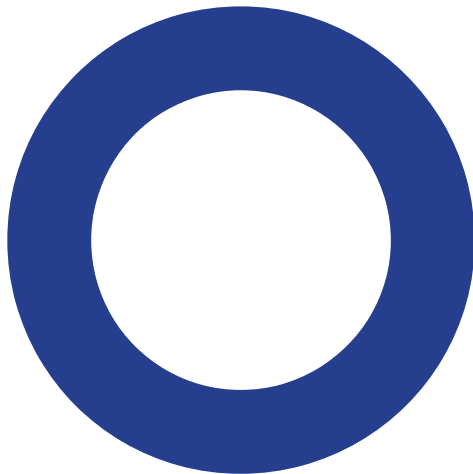
15 First Class Pre-K Classrooms

To reach 70 percent of all four-year-olds, Jackson County would need approximately:

7 additional First Class Pre-K Classrooms

\$840,000 in additional funding*

\$175,000 in one time start-up costs
