

### Jefferson County's First Class Pre-K Classrooms are located in:

- 7 Community Organization Operated
- 8 Child Care
- 11 Faith Based
- O Head Start
- 5 Private School
- 100 Public School
  - 4 University Operated

To reach 70 percent of all four-year-olds, Jefferson County would need approximately:

**\$23,160,000** in additional funding\*

**\$4,825,000** in one time start-up costs
