

# Lawrence County's First Class Pre-K Classrooms are located in:

- O Community Organization Operated
- O Child Care
- Faith Based
- O Head Start
- O Private School
- 8 Public School
- University Operated

To reach 70 percent of all four-year-olds, Lawrence County would need approximately:

additional First Class
Pre-K Classrooms

\$960,000 in additional funding\*

\$200,000 in one time start-up costs
