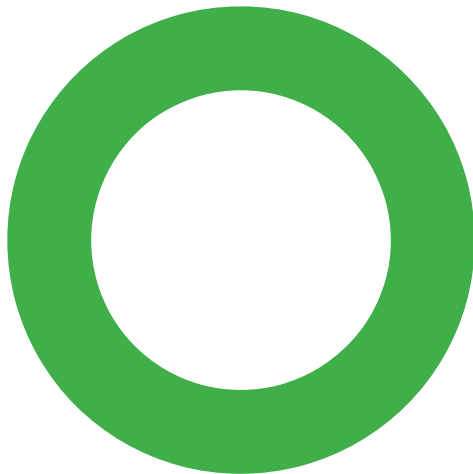

\$360,000 in additional funding\*
