

### **Madison County's First Class** Pre-K Classrooms are located in:

- 8 Community Organization Operated
- 2 Child Care
- Faith Based
- O Head Start
- 1 Private School
- 72 Public School
- 3 University Operated

To reach 70 percent of all four-year-olds, **Madison County would need approximately:** 

**10** additional First Class Pre-K Classrooms

\$10,560,000 in additional funding\*

\$2,200,000 in one time start-up costs

\*The additional funding can come from a combination of local, state, federal, or other sources.
