
# In the 2020-2021 School Year:

# Mobile County's First Class Pre-K Classrooms are located in:

- 1 Community Organization Operated
- 13 Child Care
- 2 Faith Based
- 14 Head Start
- 2 Private School
- 79 Public School
- University Operated

To reach 70 percent of all four-year-olds, Mobile County would need approximately:

\$12,720,000 in additional funding\*

\$2,650,000 in one time start-up costs
