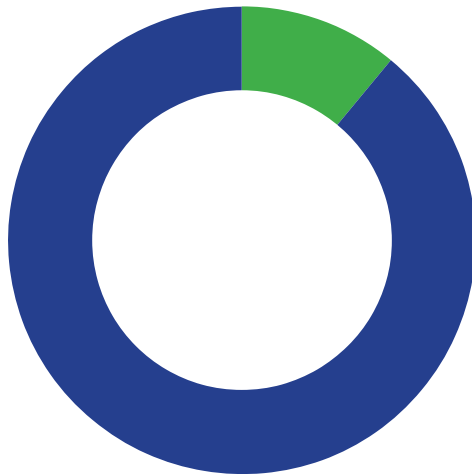

Randolph County's First Class Pre-K Classrooms are located in:

To reach 70 percent of all four-year-olds, Randolph County would need approximately:

2 additional First Class Pre-K Classrooms

\$240,000 in additional funding*

\$50,000 in one time start-up costs
