
## In the 2020-2021 School Year:

## Russell County's First Class Pre-K Classrooms are located in:

- O Community Organization Operated
- 1 Child Care
- 2 Faith Based
- O Head Start
- O Private School
- 20 Public School
  - University Operated

To reach 70 percent of all four-year-olds, Russell County would need approximately:

additional First Class Pre-K Classrooms \$1,000,000 in additional funding\*

\$225,000 in one time start-up costs

\*The additional funding can come from a combination of local, state, federal, or other sources.
