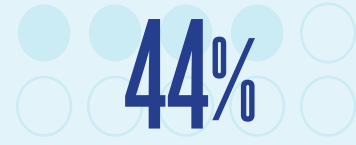

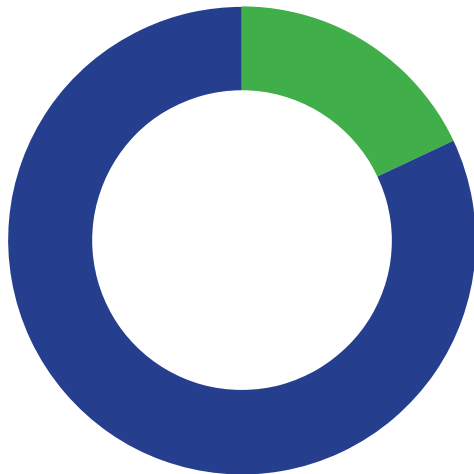
11 First Class Pre-K Classrooms

Tallapoosa County's First Class Pre-K Classrooms are located in:

To reach 70 percent of all four-year-olds, Tallapoosa County would need approximately:

7 additional First Class Pre-K Classrooms

\$840,000 in additional funding\*

\$175,000 in one time start-up costs

\*The additional funding can come from a combination of local, state, federal, or other sources.
