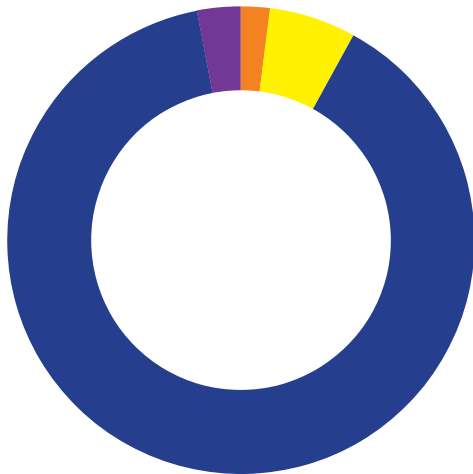
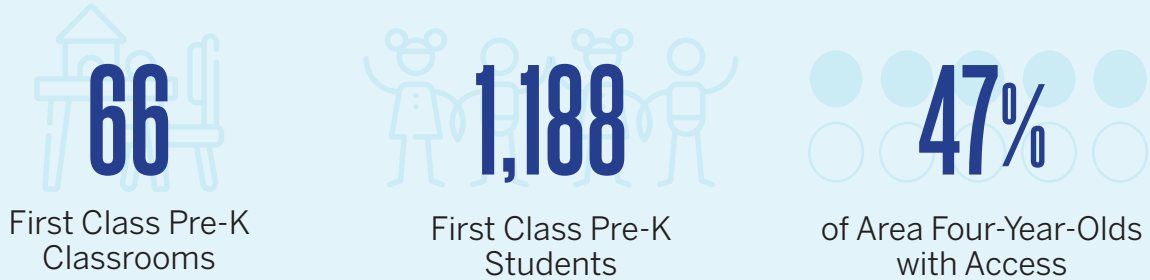


# Roadmap for Fully Funding Alabama's FIRST CLASS PRE-K PROGRAM

## TUSCALOOSA COUNTY

In the 2020-2021 School Year:



### Tuscaloosa County's First Class Pre-K Classrooms are located in:

- 0 Community Organization Operated
- 1 Child Care
- 4 Faith Based
- 0 Head Start
- 0 Private School
- 59 Public School
- 2 University Operated

To reach 70 percent of all four-year-olds, Tuscaloosa County would need approximately:

**33** additional First Class Pre-K Classrooms     **\$3,960,000** in additional funding\*     **\$825,000** in one time start-up costs

\*The additional funding can come from a combination of local, state, federal, or other sources.
